

Articulation of Transition - 1988 Core to 2013 Core

As courses for the 1988 Core are phased out and courses for the 2013 Core are phased in, students entering prior to 13/FA may take new core courses to fulfill the 1988 core requirements as follows:

IMPORTANT: Students must earn a minimum of 120 credits, complete requirements for core and a major, and maintain an appropriate GPA overall and in the major (determined by major) in order to graduate. Students must also complete the appropriate number of liberal arts credits as determined by the degree earned (BA = 90, BS = 60, MUSB = 45).
