The mission of the Inn is to address structural injustice by building relationships, respecting their human dignity, helping them restore hope in their lives, and by living simply among poor and homeless people. Come support God's children living all over the world by purchasing handmade crafts. Funds will benefit people living in developing countries. Sale will go on all day!


#### **Harry Potter and the Moral Imagination Lecture Wed., Dec. 5 at 6:30 PM**
