

### Pass/Fail Option

Full-time juniors and seniors in good academic standing may take one 3-credit elective course Pass/Fail (S/U) per semester at Nazareth College. Students in any credit-bearing S/U course may not take another S/U course during that semester. A course taken S/U may not be used to satisfy core requirements. Students may not opt to take courses in the major area(s) or minor on a Pass/Fail basis, even if all major requirements are met. The Pass/Fail Form must be completed, including a signature from the faculty advisor, and turned in to the Registrar during the first week of classes. **Pass/Fail forms are available in the Registrar's Office and in the Academic Advisement Center. You can register for the course through NazNet and then submit the pass/fail form to the Registrar's Office by the published deadline.**

Part-time students who have earned 60 or more credits and are in good academic standing may take a maximum of four elective courses Pass/Fail within their academic program at Nazareth College.

**Note:** The Pass/Fail option is not applicable during summer sessions.
