



Configure Windows ME

Setting Up a Network Connection in Windows ME

The following instructions assume that a network card has been installed in the computer or that the computer was purchased with a network card installed.

1. Click on **Start** → **Settings** → **Control Panel**
2. Double-click **Network**
3. Click on the **Identification** tab
4. Fill in the **Computer Name** box with your first and last name (i.e. John Doe)
In the **Workgroup** box, type `student`
In the **Computer Description** box, type the name of your residence hall and your room number (ex. Lyons #10) Click on the **Configuration** tab
5. Change the *Primary Network Logon* to **Windows Logon**
Double-click on the **TCP/IP** line associated with your Ethernet card (ex. *TCP/IP 3Com EtherLink*)
6. The **IP Address** tab should be visible
Click on the **Obtain an IP address automatically** button
Check the **Detect connection to network media** box
Click on the **WINS Configuration** tab
7. Click on the **Use DHCP for WINS Resolution** button
Click on the **DNS Configuration** tab
8. Click on the **Disable DNS** button
Click on the **Gateway** tab
9. Remove any numbers that appear in the boxes
Click on **OK** to close this window
10. Click on **OK** again to close the *Network* dialog box
11. You will be prompted to restart your computer
Click **Yes**
