- Sign in using your social security number, first two letters of last name, date of birth and your FAFSA PIN number.
  - If you do not know your FAFSA PIN, go to [www.pin.ed.gov](http://www.pin.ed.gov) to request a duplicate PIN and it may be displayed immediately.
- Follow the instructions to "Start the PLUS application process" and authorize a credit check.
- First time GRAD PLUS borrowers:
  - Click on "Complete the MPN" (Master Promissory Note) on the left hand side and follow the instructions for completing the GRAD PLUS loan MPN.
