- **STEP 1:** Visit studentaid.gov.
- STEP 2: Under the Parent tab, click on Apply for a Parent PLUS Loan.
 - Login with the parent federal FSA ID (do not use the student FSA ID).
- **STEP 3:** Click START to begin the **Parent PLUS application**.
 - · Select an award year.
 - Enter school, loan amount, and loan period (i.e. for fall/spring: August 2020 May 2021).
 - Complete authorizations and submit application.
- **STEP 4:** Complete Parent PLUS Master Promissory Note (MPN).
 - Under the Parent tab, click Complete a Master Promissory Note for a Parent PLUS Loan.
 - Sign and submit MPN.
