

Nazareth Course Delivery Definitions

These guidelines were modified from <u>Allen & Seaman's definition</u> of online course types (p. 7) and endorsed by the Faculty Senate on 3/24/23.

Proportion of Course Delivered Online	Type of Course	Description	Section Codes
0-29%	Face-to-Face & Web-Enhanced (FIP)	Course is delivered in a face-to-face fashion in a traditional classroom. May include up to 29% of class time delivered fully online with a corresponding reduction in onsite meetings. Course content may be enhanced by use of the online learning management system (LMS).	01-59
30-79%	Hybrid (HYB)	Course that blends online and face-to-face delivery. At least 30% of class time is delivered fully online using the LMS with at least a 30% correlated reduction in face-to-face meetings.	80-89
80-99%	Mostly Online (ONLM)	Course where most of the content is delivered online using the LMS. Mostly online courses include limited face-to-face components, like exams or presentations, but the face-to-face components make up less than 20% of the course.	70-79
100%	Fully Online (ONLINE)	Course where all of the content is delivered online using the LMS with no face-to-face components. Instructors may meet virtually with students at pre-designated times.	70-79
100%	Live Online (ONL)	Course where all of the content is delivered online using the LMS with no face-to-face components. Students must attend regularly scheduled virtual sessions with the instructor.	70-79
